**Minutes of the General Meeting**

**May 5, 2021**

This in-person meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by President, Rick Najera in Chris Carter's warehouse. There were 21 members present, which included all four club officers. Treasurer, Jeff Beam, reported that there were now 63 current members and that the club is in good financial standing.

**Old Business**

**Truck Show, Plymouth, CA April 24** No one present attended, but the club did receive an email from John Basile saying what a great show it was.

**Hagerty Cars & Caffeine, Sonoma Raceway, April 24** No one present attended.

**SFO Exhibit, Club Ride, May 22** Chris Carter will be calling the curator to set a time to view this exhibit. All agreed it would be good to meet at an assigned location and ride in together. Rolling Pin Donuts in San Bruno was suggested and the group concurred. Mario DiSalvo had some route ideas for after the exhibit and various lunch ideas were discussed. Chris will send an email with confirmation of time, gathering spot (Rolling Pin) and lunch location.

**Six Chapter Ride, June 25-27** Brian Davis and Ricky both conveyed that response has been strong for this event and that all six California chapters have members already booked at the KOA in Cloverdale. Ricky estimates around 50 attendees. Since it will be a very informal ride, the only meal to deal with would be Saturday night. Mario wondered if the caterer from Monterey (Gonzo) would be willing to come that far. Benito will check with him. Chris Carter asked if the woman that runs the KOA would have any caterer recommendations. Ricky mentioned that we really only need to throw some burgers on a BBQ. He also said that Paul Thomas, North Bay Road Captain, has the routes set up. Brian Davis reminded us that the Felton Run a few years back was very unplanned and it went well, so this will be similar.

**AMCA/Yerba Buena @ IMS, Sonoma Raceway, July 16-18** Brian Davis spoke with Keith Kizer at National who explained that, initially, this request went to the Yerba Buena chapter, but now Keith has opened it up to all the chapters in the area. It's a chance for chapters to display 6-8 bikes and be part of the team that mans the AMCA table at this outdoor trade show. The International Motorcycle Show is scheduled at nine different weekends throughout the country; Northern California will be the first one.
