Minutes of the General Meeting

September 6, 2023

Our chapter meeting was called to order by Treasurer Brian Davis at 7:05 pm at Harry's Hofbrau in Redwood City. The Treasurer informed us that we had no expenses last month and we remain in good financial standing.

Old Business

Niles Car Show August 13 Ted Morris reported that over 600 cars were registered for this event. Gary Oliveira did a great job of getting our club a corner spot; Yerba Buena had about ten members show up. Mark Wiebens had quite an entrance with no exhaust connected on his bike and everyone was sure to know where the antique motorcycles were located. Brian Davis concluded that the weather was great and it was a terrific show.

Rigid Ride August 13 Chris Carter estimated that 20 bikers attended this ride which was a good turnout. It started on Arastradero Road near the Open Space parking lot, traveled over Skyline to Peterson's Store in Pescadero, and ended up at the 101 Brewery on the coast for lunch.

Evergreen Swap Meet, Tenino Washington August 17-18 No one present attended.

Scott's Valley Motorcycle Concourse August 27. Brad Booth stated that this was a really good show on a huge lawn area with probably around 150 bikes. Chris Carter informed us that it used to be a runway. He explained that this show is a fund raiser for a non-profit and to register a bike was \$30. They had all kinds of categories: Motocross, Japanese, American, Electric, British, to name a few. It was a nice mix and a good showing.

Alviso Santos Family Car Show September 2 Ted Morris commented on this event: they close down the whole downtown and it's a really good show.
